Tuesday the 29
this day commences with light breeze
and rainy weather from the S.W.
ship steering N.E. by N. ship's sail
double reefed topsail and foresail
later four light breeze and good
weather from the N.W. ship steering
N.E. by N. all sail set heading
in from the land so ends the day

In the Japan Sea March

Wednesday the 30
this day commences with light breeze
and good weather from the W. the
ship steering N.E. by N. all sail set
heading in for the land later four
strong breeze and good weather from the
S.W. ship steering N.E. by N. all sail
set the Cosima Islands in sight and
the main bound into the straits of Suruga
one to Macadaba broke out molasses
so ends the day

Thursday the 31
this day commences with a strong
breeze and a storm ship under
double reefed topsail and jib
the heading of shore the wind N.W.
the islands in sight later four strong
breeze and good weather from the N.W.
ship running into the straits of Maeser
bound to Macadaba so ends the day

Friday April the 1st
this day commences with light breeze
and good weather from the W. ship in
the straits beyond to the port of
Macadaba broke out water got the anchors
of the bow later four good weather
come to anchor at Macadaba
broke out casks from water
so ends the day
