so ends the day

Tuesday the 5

this day commences with good weather
the ship lying at anchor one watch
ashore on liberty the other watch
stowing water latter part good weather
ship at anchor one watch
ashore on liberty
so ends the day

this day commences at anchor one
watch ashore on liberty took on
board a raft water latter part
good weather the ship at anchor one
watch ashore on liberty
so ends the day

Thursday the 7

this day commences with good weather
the ship lying at anchor one
watch ashore on liberty took on board
some beans and rice latter part good
weather ship at anchor all hands
aboard of the ship.
so ends the day

Friday the 8

this day commences at with good
weather the ship at anchor all hands
aboard getting ready for sea broke
out some sugar latter part good weather
took the anchor and made sail and
stood out to sea so ends the day

Saturday the 9

this day commences with bad weather full
back into the harbor again and
come to anchor broke out a cask of
bread latter part bad weather ship at anchor
waiting for weather to go to sea
so ends the day
