this day commences with strong breeze and rugged weather from the E ship heading N by NW half W all sail set passed into American island passage into Ochotk sea the island in sight latter part strong breeze and a thick snow storm from the E ship steering N double reef topsails and courses so much the day

Saturday the 23

this day commences with strong breeze and a thick snow storm from the E ship heading N by W single reef top sails and courses in the Ochotk sea broke out meat latter part strong breeze and rugged weather from the W ship heading N N E double reef topsails and courses so much the day

Sunday the 24

this day commences with strong breeze and cold rugged weather from the W ship heading N N W double reef topsails and courses latter part strong breeze and snow squalls from the N W ship with single reef topsails and maintopgallant sail heading N N E so much the day

Monday the 25

this day commences with strong breeze and rugged weather from the N W ship heading N N E single reef topsails and maintopgallant sail set latter part strong breeze and good weather from the N W ship heading N N E all sail set so much the day

Tuesday the 26

this day commences with strong breeze and rugged weather from the W ship heading N by W double reef topsails and courses latter part strong breeze and rough cold weather from the N ship heading W by N all sail set broke out for water so much the day

this day commences with strong breeze and rough cold weather from the N W ship heading N N E all sail set in the Ochotk sea latter part strong breeze and good weather from the W N W ship heading N W all sail set so much the day
