this day commences with strong gales and stormy weather from the S E ship heading on either tack of and on from the ice the land in sight latter part strong breeze and good weather from the S E ship standing off and on from the ice and land & ship in sight gamming with the L. C. Richmond so ends the day

Monday the 23

this day commences with strong breeze and good weather from the S E ship standing off and on from the ice and land & ship in sight gamming with the L. C. Richmond latter part strong breeze and good weather from the S E ship on either tack of and on from the land gamming with the Girl Holland & ship in sight so ends the day

Tuesday the 24

this day commences with light breeze and a thick foggy from the S E ship heading on either tack of and on from the land latter part light breeze and foggy weather from the S E ship heading to the Westward broke out a bag of butter some rice 1 1/2 barrel of meat so ends the day

Wednesday the 25

this day commences with light breeze and thick weather from the S W ship heading to the Westward all sail set gamming with the Girl Holland broke out for water and a cask of bread latter part strong breeze and thick weather from the S W ship working round the ice to the Westward the ice in sight so ends the day

Thursday the 26

this day commences with strong breeze and cloudy weather from the S W ship laying ~~the~~ with the foretack aback the ice in sight latter part light breeze and cloudy weather from the S W ship heading on either tack working to the Westward all sail set so ends the day

Friday the 27

this day commences with light breeze and foggy weather from the S W ship on either tack working to the Westward all sail set gamming with the ship Congress Captain Altranberg latter part light breeze and thick foggy from the S W ship heading on either tack working through the ice all sail set so ends the day
