Friday the 3

this day commences with light breeze
and a thick fog from the N.W. the
ship running around amongst the ice in
Davis Bay. broke out 2 1/2 barrels of
meat. latter part light breeze and good
weather from the S.E. ship heading in
to the North shore all sail set
30 miles the day

Saturday the 4

this day commences with light breeze
and foggy weather from the S.E.
ship heading in to Fabius island got
the anchors of the lower and bent
the chains latter part light breeze and
a thick fog ship laying at anchor boats
of cruising for whales ice all around
30 miles the day

Sunday the 5

this day commences with a thick foggy
ship at anchor of Fabius island
boats all of cruising for whales
plenty of ice latter part a thick
fog ship at anchor boats of cruising
for whales but got nothing plenty of
ice round the ship
30 miles the day

Monday the 6

this day commences with light breeze
and thick fog ship at anchor off
Fabius island boats of cruising for whales
plenty of ice and whales in sight
latter part light breeze and a thick foggy
ship at anchor of the island block in
the ice boats all on board
30 miles the day

Tuesday the 7

this day commences with light breeze
and good weather ship at anchor
block in solid with ice boats all
on board latter part ship at anchor
four boats of cruising for whales
30 miles the day

Wednesday the 8

this day commences at anchor the
boats all of cruising for whales
the latter part the same
30 miles the day

Thursday the 9

this day commences at anchor of
Fabius island the boats all returned
on board. latter part light breeze and
good weather got underweigh made sail
and stood up the bay all sail set
three boats of cruising for whales broke
out water sugar coffee
30 miles the day
