This day begins with
fine weather like breeze
from S.W. ship heading
S.E. with all sail
saw 2 sail steering
S.E. at 1.00 like breeze
from W.N.W. steering S.E.
at 6 P.M. set fore topmast
and main top gablet standing
sail

This day begins with
fine weather fine breeze
from W by S ship
steering S.E. by S
at 6 P.M. squally wind shifted
to S.W. shortened sail
at 9 P.M. reefed topsails
wind increased ship
heading E

This day begins with strong
breeze from S.W. ship
heading E at 2 P.M. set main top
galeut sail at 3 P.M. set fore
top galeut sail and fly jib
wind S ship heading S.E.

This day begins with
strong souther ship under
doble reefed topsails
heaving S.E. at 1.00 took
in jib and mainsail and close
reefed topsails at 2 P.M. furled

This day begins with
heavy gail from S
ship heading E and S.E.
with close reefed topsails
and foresail at 6 P.M.
set doble reefed topsails and
main sail at 10 P.M. squally
wind S.E. ship heading E

This day begins with strong
breeze from S.E. ship
heading E. and S by N
with all prudent sail
at 6 P.M. took ship head
