This day begins with fine weather strong breeze from S.E. ship heading S.W. with all prudent sail at 7 a.m. tacked heading E. by S at 8 P.M. tacked head. S.E. W. wind S.E.

Sunday September 27th

This day begins with fine breeze from S. East ship heading S.E. W. with all sail at 2 a.m. tacked ship head E. at 5 a.m. tacked ship head S.E. W. at 1 P.M. ship heading S.E. W. wind S.E. later part about the same

Long 4. 25 West

Monday September 28th

Got a lunar and found the chronometer about right

This day begins with fine weather wind S.E. ship heading S.W. with all sail at 11 a.m. ship heading S.E. wind E. Middle and later part about the same so ends this day

Tuesday September 29th

This day begins with fine weather wind S.E. ship heading S.E. at 11 a.m. wind N.E. ship steering E. S. E. at 7 P.M. steering E. by S half S fitting blubber room

Wednesday September 30th

Sudden shift of wind

This day begins with fine weather strong breeze from N.E. ship steering E. by S at 8 P.M. wind shifted to west Hoisting strong shortened sail at 10 P.M. made sail set topmast studding sail and top galeant studding sail

This day begins with strong breeze from W. with rain ship steering E. S. E. with all sail Middle and later part fine weather fine breeze from W. S. W. steering E. S. E. with all sail
