This day begins with heavy
gale from S ship heading

topsail at 6 A.M. Moderated
cept off steering E. by S
with close reefed topsails
and foresail, wind S.S.W.
by compass at 9 P.M. turned
reefs out and set main top gal
sail for 66

This day begins with heavy
weather Strong breeze
from S.S.W. ship steering
E by S with all prudent
sail Middle of the day squally
later part fine weather
like wind from S ship heading
E by S

This day begins with fine
weather wind like and
batten from S.S.W. Middle
and later part wind W.N.W.
Ship steering E.S.E. with
all sail

Friday October 23rd

This day begins with fine
weather wind W ship steering
E.S.E. by compass at 2 P.M.
taken in studding sails and
fore topgalent sail
Strong westerly gale ship
steering E.S.E.

Saturday October 24th

This day begins with
Strong gale from W
Ship steering E.S.E.
with all prudent sail
at 3 A.M. put one reef
in fore and main topsail
at 3 P.M. Equally at 11
put 2 reefs in fore and
main topsail blowing
heavily from W. steering
E.S.E.

Long 67. 10 E

Sunday October 25th

This day begins with
Strong westerly gale
at 7 A.M. wind veered to
S.S.W. ship steering
E.S.E. at 1 A.M. moderated
at 6 P.M. fine weather wind
W ship steering E.S.E.
with all sail at 11 P.M. heavy
squalls shortened sail to close
reefed main topsail
