from S and Westward
middle of this day
squally from S W
at 1 PM put 2 reefs
in the topsails heavy
squalls from S W

First of this 24 hours
blowing heavy from
S and squally at 7 am
taken in jib and
mainsail at 11 am heavy
squalls at 2 furled foresail
at 3 PM stowed foretop sail
blowing heavy from S

This day begins with
heavy gale from S ship
heading S E close reefed
mainsail at 7 am set
fore sail and fore top sail
at 8 PM all sail wind
S W steering S E by E

Saw whales and
got one got him
along side at 3 am



First of this 24 hours
fine weather wind S W
steering S E by E
filling pennants to
fore top sail was
at 5 am saw whales heard
and got one and huck
him to the ship at 6 PM
commenced cutting
