

Remarks December 18. 1857
Sunday December 13th

heavy gail, from S. at 10 AM ship
heading S. E. at 2 PM were round head
by 10 PM close reefed main
topsail heavy squalls land
bearing E dist 25 miles middle part
at 2 PM moderated set fore
topsail later part, mail
sail at 10 saw land
steered for it wind S. W. steering
S. E. do ends this day
Lat 43.30 N
Long 177.30 W

Monday Dec 14th

running for the land with
Chatham Strong low west gail at 5 AM
island came to anchor at 10 PM but
later got left water

Tuesday December 15th

at Chatham island first of this
24 hours giting water and showing
it down later part got off
raft water and finished showing
down

Chatham Island

Bark, Mides of J. D. Salaman Master
Wednesday Dec 16th

at Chatham island water, all on
board 250 barrels later part 3 boats
went after potatoes had 4 men to run
away. Wamer, Witter, Sanford, Hudson

Thursday December 17th

getting off potatoes bad weather
at 9 AM all on board 2 PM got wet
later part caught 1 man by the name of
Wamer

Friday December 18th

Trading with the natives solved
3 boxes tobacco later part doing
nothing waiting for men

Saturday December 19th

got 2 fine hogs 2 boats fishing and gunning
Captain went to tubung to find
his men later part doing heavy
from S. W.
