First of this day fine weather
wind W steering N at 4 am
spoke ship John Byrd
at 7 saw 1 whale middle part
fine weather later part wind
E N E steering S E saw
nothing

Friday Jan 8th

First of this day wind E and
E S E heading N at 4 rainy
spoke ship Silver Cloud
middle part fine weather
wind W heading E later
part fine weather wind W
heading S E saw several
ships

Lat 48.30 S
Long 158.30 W

Saturday Jan 9th

First of this day fine weather
Saw whales wind W heading S E saw
whales at 3 boarded and chased
them at 7 came on board at 9
shortened sail middle part
wind W thick and raining
at 7 PM wind shifted to S
rainy saw nothing

Long 158.00 W

Bark Abigail of R. Salaman Master
Sunday Jan 10th

First of this day wind S
heading W at 7 am wind
S W wore ship heading
S E 2 reefs in main topsail
and fore sail middle part fine
weather at 3 PM made sail wind W
steering E so ends this day

Lat 48.42 S
Long 156.50 W

Monday Jan 11th

First of this day fine weather wind
W steering N E saw sail to windward
middle part wind N heading E by N
later part thick and rainy
heading E N E with 2 reefs in topsails
and courses so ends this day

Tuesday Jan 12th

First of this day wind N
heading E N E with all sail
at 11 am wind W N W steering
S E by N later part
fine weather repairing fly
gibb so ends this day
