Thursday Jan 21st

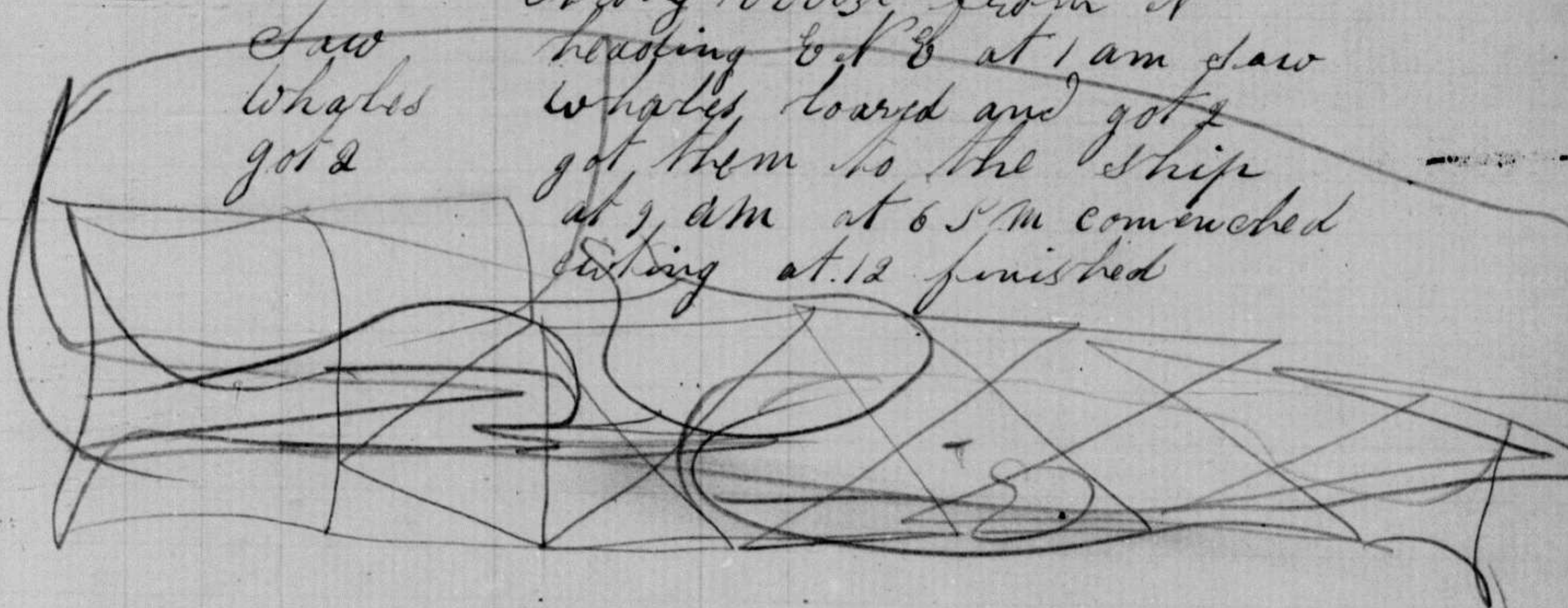
First of this day fine

like air from W. steering N. by E
middle part wind N. heading
N. E. later part the same
Lat 30.20 S
Long 129.50 W

Saturday Jan 23rd

Fine weather
strong breeze from N.
heading E. N. E. at 1 am saw
whales
got 2
got them to the ship
at 9 am at 6 PM commenced
drying at 12 finished



Sunday Jan 24th

First of this day
blowing fresh from N.
heading E. N. E. finished
cutting blubber at 5 PM
ship middle part
blowing strong from N.
and rainey at 1 PM wind
shifted to W. wore round
head later part fine
weather boiling
Lat 30.00 S
Long 127.00 W
