Saturday Feb. 13th

First of this day strong N^W E
wind steering N^W by all sail
middle part the same later
part ditto Lat 10.48 N^o
Long 139.48 W^o

Sunday Feb. 14th

Saw S.P.
Whales

First of this day fine
weather wind N^W E steering
N^W at 5 a.m. saw sperm
whales loosed and chased.
They did not get my them
at 7 a.m. tacked ship head S E.
at 2 P.M. tacked head N later
part fine weather steering N^W
by W saw nothing Lat 11.35 N^o
Long 140.30 W^o

Monday Feb. 15th

First of this day fine weather
wind E N E steering N^W by W
with all sail middle part
fine weather later part like
air and bafin from N and E
employed breaking out shocks
and setting up casks
Lat 12.30 N^o

Long 142.57 W^o

Tuesday Feb 16th

First of this day fine weather
like air and bafin from N and
westward heading N^W by W and N^W
middle part fine weather wind
E N E steering N^W later part
wind E; setting up shocks
Lat 14.00 N^o

Long 143.13 W^o

Bark Abidas of R. Tallman Master
Wednesday Feb 17th

First of this day fine breeze
from E steering N^W by W
middle part fine weather
later part the same employed setting
up shocks and painting boats

Lat 15.45 N^o
Long 145.34 W^o

Thursday Feb 18th

First of these 24 hours fine
weather fine breeze from E N E
steering N^W by W¹/₂ W by compass.
employed setting up casks for water
middle part like air and bafin
from E later part like breeze
from E S E steering N^W by W
with all sail so ends this day
Lat 16.25 N^o

Long 146.37 W^o

Friday Feb 19th

First of this day fine weather
like breeze from E S E steering
N^W by compass; employed
painting boats. Middle part
like equally weather later part
fine weather steering N^W by S

Lat 17.28 N^o
Long 148.17 W^o
