Saturday Feb 20

First of this day fine weather
like breeze from E & steering
W by N. by compass employed
at ship's duty. Middle
part fine breeze later part
like air and calm at 10 PM
saw a break about 5 miles
off; employed washing ship
Lat 18.04. N
Long 150.04 W

Sunday Feb 21st

First of this day calm at 9 am
strong breeze from N at 9 am
wind W & steering W by N
by compass at 1 PM wind veered
at 3 blowing fresh later part moderated
at 5 set studding sails steering
W by N Lat 19.10. N
Long 152.20. W

Monday Feb 22nd

First of this day fine weather
fine breeze from E & steering
W by N. Middle part
wind like later part wind
S & steering W by N at 7 PM
saw the island of Hawaii
bearing W by N distant
about 50 miles
Lat 20.00 N
Long 154.00 W

Bark Nolas J B Salmon Master
Tuesday Feb 23rd

First of this day fine
weather wind S by E steering
W by N at 7 am the harbor
of Hilo bears S W
about 10 miles
at 10 PM ship middle part
lying off and on at 6 PM
stood in shore at 11 got
a pilot at 12 came to
anchor at Hilo Sandwich is
sent raft coals a shore
and scrubbed ship's bends

Wednesday Feb 24th

braking out and cooping
meat people on liberty

Thursday - 25

fine weather painting
ship on liberty

Friday

26th
painting ship watch
on liberty

Saturday Feb

27

Employed at ship's duty

landed provisions for ship navy
watch on liberty

Sunday

Feb 28

watch on liberty lost sails and
sails then

Monday

Feb 29

Braking out provisions
and landing them on shore
all hands to work
