

Remarks for March 14. 1858
Sunday Mar 14th

First of this day strong N.E. wind
middle part the same ship under
2 reefs topsail later part moderated
Sperm whales @ 6 P.M. saw rani bearing N.E.
dist. about 25 miles @ 7 P.M. saw
got 1 and struck another sperm whale topped and got 1
harbord boat struck and drew
slightly fast saw several more
got the whale along side @ 12

Monday Mar 15th

Fine weather @ 2 am commenced cutting
@ 10 finished cutting middle part
cutting cable at 7 P.M. started the
works the island of Molokai in sight
and saw several ships

Tuesday Mar 16th

Fine weather wind light and bafflin
gamed with the clouds asackward of
Pantucket @ 7 am diamond head
in sight middle part hove too
@ 6 capt off for the land @ 8 P.M.
captain went on shore at Honolulu

Ship lying off and on several ships
lying off and on

Wednesday Mar 17th

First of this day fine weather
lying off and on @ Honolulu
boiling @ 5 A.M. captain came on board
capt off steering W middle part
the same later part finished.
boiling whale turned up @ 6

First of this day calm employed
@ ships duty stowed anchor and
chain middle part light air and rany
@ 6 P.M. saw storm later part calm and
rany saw several sail @ 7 saw
onow bearing W ship heading W.N.W

Friday March 19th

First of this day light airs from Sathward
with rain the island of Atoua bore
E dist. 15 miles onow bears W dist 30 miles
2 ships in sight @ 7 am wind light and
bafflin middle part @ 11 light breeze from E
later part wind E steering W by S spoke
ship hitman of Woodward. weather
thick and rainy

Saturday March 20th

First of this day thick and rainy wind E
steering W by S with all sail
middle part thick and rainy
wind E steering W by S by compass
later part the same rounding the
harbord boat
