Sunday Mar. 21st

First of this day fine breeze from
& steering W with all sail thick
and rainy middle part strong
N & wind steering W later part
squally steering W by N with
all sail

Lat 21.40. N

Monday March 22nd

First of this day fine weather
with strong N & wind steering W by N
with all sail middle part the
same later part with employed
a setting up foremast back stays
and head stays

Lat 22.30 N
Long 170.10 W

Tuesday Mar. 23rd

First of this day fine weather
strong N & wind steering
W by N middle part fine
weather later part the same
picking potatoes and stowing
them in the run

Lat 23.40. N
Long 173.20. W

Wednesday Mar. 24th

First of this day fine weather
wind E & S steering W by N
middle part fine weather later
part the same strong N & wind
steering W. N. W. employed at
picking potatoes & ends
this day

Lat 24.56. N
Long 176.39. W

Thursday March 25th

First of this 24 hours fine weather
strong breeze from N & steering
N W by W with all sail
middle part the same later part
moderated fine pleasant weather
employed a ships duty broke
out for stops and small stores
so ends this day

Lat 26.45. N
Long 178.47. W

Friday Mar. 26th

Stowed
down 64. bbls
of S. S. oil

First of this 24 hours fine pleasant
weather like breeze from E steering
N W by W with all sail
middle part fine weather like
breeze from E. S. E steering
N W by W later part the same
stowing down oil so
ends this day
