Sunday March 28th

First of this day fine weather
like breeze from S.E. steering
N.W. with all sail. thick
smokey weather middle part
@ 12 wind like later part @
2 P.M. wind veered to N. in squall
shortened sail @ 4 P.M.
hoove too under close reefed
main topsail wind N heading
W. by N.
No observation

Monday March 29

First of this 24 hours blowing strong
from N.N.E. ship heading N.W.
with 2 reefs topsails and foresail
@ 1 am wore ship heading E
middle part blowing on taken in
fore topsail later part @ 6 P.M.
set fore topsail full and mainsail
wind N.E. steering N.W. by W.
by compass 1 point variation
Lat 27.35. N
Long 177.36. E

Tuesday March 30th

First of this day strong N.E. wind
with heavy swell steering N.W. by W.
sail 2 reefs topsails main top full
sail middle part full breeze from
S.E. later part thick fog and
like air from S.E. steering N.W.
No observation

First of this day thick fog like
breeze from S.E. steering N.W.
middle part full same
later part thick fog wind S
steering N.W. by W. with all sail
employed setting up sheets

Thursday April 1st

First of this day like air from
S with thick fog steering N.W.
employed setting up casts
middle part thick strong breeze from
N.N.W. heading W. with hole topsails
and courses at 4 P.M. put 2 reefs in
fore topsail blowing fresh from
N heading N.W. by W. @ 10 P.M.
set main topgal & full setting up casts

Friday April 2nd

First of this day fine weather
wind N steering N.W. by W.
with all sail
@ 9 am wind veered to N.E.
fine breeze later part wind
S.E. steering N.W. employed
repairing mainsail
