Saturday Apr 3rd

First of this day fine weather
wind S steering N.W. by S
with all sail at 1 a.m. wind
shifted to W blowing strong
and raining shorting sails to
2 reef topsails heading S. by W
later part the same

Sunday April 4th

First of this day blowing strong
from W by N heading S by W
heavy swell from S.W. employed
repairing sail @ 6 P.M. wind S
steering S.W. by W @ 1 P.M.
blowing fresh put 2 reefs in
fore and main topsail

Monday April 5th

First of this day blowing heavy
from S.E. W steering S.W. by S
with 2 topsails at 7 a.m. wind veered
to S.W. head N.E. @ 10 a.m. ship
head W by S @ 6 P.M. set 2 topsails
and gibs and mainsail blowing
strong from S.W. W heading
W

First of this day blowing fresh
from S.W. heading W and
S.W. @ 1 a.m. wore ship head
S by E middle part blowing strong
from S.W. @ 11 a.m. wore ship
head S.W. by S later blowing
heavy from W by W
Lat 39.00 N
Long 167.15 E

Wednesday April 7th

First of this day blowing heavy
in squalls from W. by W heading
S. with prudent sail
middle part like calm weather heading
S by E later part like air from
S heading W by W with all sail
employed mending foresail
@ 10 P.M. commenced raining

Thursday April 8th

First of this day thick and rainy
weather strong breeze from S.W.
steering S.W. by W with all
sail @ 3 a.m. bent new fore sail
at 7 showed fore top gal sail
at 9 showed main top gal sail and fly
gibb @ 8 a.m. set reefed topsails
and showed gibb blowing heavy in
squalls later part moderate
set long reef topsails and m. top gal sail
