Thursday April 15th

First of this day ^{fine} weather
wind E. steering S by W with
sing reefed top sails and courses
middle part like weather wind S E
heading S. S. W. at 6 P.M. made
all sail later part employed
mending bow boat and repairing
the davit to ends this day
No observation

Friday April 16th

First of this day wind like
and baffling at 7 am heading W
Harbord tacks a board
middle part wind like and bafflin
at 1 P.M. tack ship head
with Harbord tacks a board
at 10 P.M. tacked head W by S
No observation

Saturday April 17th

First of this day like wind and
bafflin from S by W heading
W by S Middle part calm
latter part wind like and bafflin
from S and Eastward
Lat 46.25 N
Long 155.07 E

Sunday April 18th

First of this day fine weather
like air and bafflin heading
S at 4 am steering S by E
wind. Middle part wind like
and bafflin steering S by E
later part the same
Lat 47.00 N
Long 155.20 E

Monday April 19th

First of this day like air and
bafflin at 4 am wind S. E steering
S by E Middle part like air and
bafflin later part like breeze
from S steering S employed
repairing jib and fore topgallant
sail gaff topsail and foresail
Lat 48.00 N
Long 155.00 E by account

Tuesday April 20th

First of this day fine breeze from
Saw sail. Steering S saw ship steering
to S and westward at 4 am bent
fore topsail and fore top gall sail
middle part steering S later part
at 6 P.M. steering S by W
at 10 P.M. saw Paramore bearing
S distant 15 miles on course
bearing S. E. W dist. 10 miles
at 12 past. thru the 50.00 passage
Lat 50.00 N
Long 155.00 E
