

Remarks for May. 1858

Thursday 20th

First of this day, thick fog
at 4 am bore ship saw land
bearing N.W. distant 8
miles wind like breeze S.W.
heading S.E. & is ship in sight
all standing in for the day
middle part blowing strong
from N.W. heading W. by S bore
poles later part fine weather
strong breeze from N.W. bore
ship several ships

Lat 58 30 N

Friday May 21st

First of this day fine weather
wind S.W. heading N.E.
under bare poles saw 2 ships
in the sea middle part drifted
out of the ice later part, fine
weather wind S.W. spoke the
Hemrod saw several ships
all working up around the
ice

Saturday May 22nd

First of this day fine weather
wind S.W. gaining with Bore
John Webbs. Middle part fine
weather later part the same saw
several ships all working
around the ice

Bark Middel of R. Tallman Master

Saturday May 30th

First of this day thick fog
working up to clear water
middle part thick strong
fresh from S.E. later part
the same heading S.W.
with 2 reefs

Lat 58 20 N

Sunday May 31st

First of this day blowing
fresh from S.E. with 2 reefs
top sails
middle part thick fog at 11 am
bore ship head S.W. wind S.E. &
blowing fresh later part
sailing wind S heading E

No other

Tuesday June 1st

First of this day thick and
rainy wind S heading S.W.
short sail middle part
thick fog at 11 bore ship
heading S.W. later part
the same saw 2 ships
wind S.W.
