

Remarks for June 1858

Wednesday June 2<sup>nd</sup>

First of this day thick fog  
wind S.W. heading W.S.W.  
at 5 am saw fog island bearing  
S.P.W. dist 20 miles sea dist  
10 miles Middle part lying with  
head yards aback at 3 P.M. stood  
up to the ice. later part working  
to the Eastward. Saw several  
ships in the ice. ahead island  
bearing E. dist 20 miles  
Lat 59.00.00  
Long 150.00.00

Thursday June 3<sup>rd</sup>

First of this day fine weather  
wind S.W. ahead Island  
bearing E. dist 20 miles Saw several  
ships in the ice  
Middle part thick fog wind S.  
lying with head yards aback  
later part wind S.W. working  
up to the ice Saw 2 ships

Friday June 4<sup>th</sup>

First of this day thick fog  
at 4 am wind S.W. saw the land  
bearing E. distant 5 miles  
Middle part wind S.W.  
lying with head yards aback  
later part fine weather  
ahead island bearing S.E.  
see thin

Saturday June 5<sup>th</sup>

First of this day fine  
weather wind S.E. and bafflin  
at 4 am got out of the  
ice as strong breeze from  
S.E. heading S.E.W. with  
2 reefs in topsails  
middle part thick fog and strong  
fresh later part the same  
saw the land bearing S.E.  
distant 15 miles

Sunday June 6<sup>th</sup>

First of this day thick  
at 1 am saw a whale and  
loosed. fog then came to  
blowing fresh went on board  
wind S.E.  
middle and later part  
the same

Monday June 7<sup>th</sup>

First of this day fine weather  
wind S.W. saw whales  
loosed and chased them in  
the ice at 7 came on board  
middle part thick fog  
later part the same  
at 6 P.M. went in the ice  
at 11 saw whale loosed  
and got it and huck him  
to the ship
