

Remarks for June 1858
Fauvesk Bay

Tuesday June 9th
First of this day thick
fog plenty of ice at 2 am
commenced cutting at 6 finished
at 8 am started the works
middle part thick fog
later part fine weather
Capead island bearing
S E distant 9 miles
Several ships in sight

Wednesday June 9th
First of this day fine weather
Saw 1 whale
wind like and bafflin
boiling at 7 pm saw 1 whale
boarded but did not see him
again middle part fine
weather like air and bafflin
later part at 7 P.M. saw a whale
boarded boat and went in the ice
in shape did not see any more
of him at 9 finished boiling
Several ships in sight Capead
island bearing S E dist 8 miles

Thursday June 10th
First of this day fine weather
boats came on board at 2 am
at 8 am wind heading W. S. W.
See thin middle part fine weather
short sail standing to the westward
later part blowing down oil
saw several ships ahead
Island bearing S. E fog Island
bearing W. No other

Bark Midas of R. Tallman Master
Friday June 11th

First of this day fine weather
wind S. E. blowing down air
saw several ships to anchor
in Fabis Island harbor
middle part blowing back
later part like air and varied
standing in for the land

Saturday June 12th
First of this day like breeze
from S.W. at 5 am came to
anchor at point in
27 fathoms of water
at 5 P.M. the boats left
the ships.
There is 1 ship to anchor
here

Sunday June 13th
First of this day fine weather
calm at 7 am the boats came
on board saw nothing
at 5 P.M. the boats left the ships
saw three whales did not
get any ship to anchor
So ends this day
