Monday June 14<sup>th</sup>

First of this day fine weather  
The whalers & birds saw several  
did not get any  
@ 5 P.M. the boats left the ship  
did not see any thing  
Ship to anchor at sunset

Tuesday June 15<sup>th</sup>

First of this day thick fog  
and calm boats came on board  
@ 7 A.M.  
@ 3 P.M. the boats left the ship  
Saw 4 whales going fast  
to the westward So ends this  
day

Wednesday June 16<sup>th</sup>

First of this day fine weather  
The boats at off whaling came  
on board @ 7 A.M.  
@ 3 P.M. the boats left the ship  
thick fog saw nothing

Thursday June 17<sup>th</sup>

First of this day thick fog  
The boats came on board  
@ 7 A.M.  
Middle part thick fog  
at 5 P.M. hoisted the boats  
and got 4 boats of wood  
Saw nothing

Friday June 18<sup>th</sup>

First of this day fine weather  
like airs from S.W. at 2 A.M.  
got under way from open  
point heading over to ahead  
island saw 13 ships all standing  
out of the fog  
middle part like airs and  
baffling @ 3 P.M. strong breeze  
from S.E. steering S.W.  
@ 7 hauled on the wind  
heading S

Lat 58.. 35. N  
Long 149.. 47. E

Saturday June 19<sup>th</sup>

First of this day fine weather  
like breeze from S.W. heading  
N. by N  
Middle part thick fog wind S.W.  
Ship heading S.E. @ 6 P.M.  
backed ship head S.W.  
Saw 1 sail to S.W.  
No observation
