Sunday June 20<sup>th</sup>

First of this day fine weather  
like air and bafflin from S  
and eastward heading S.W.  
Employed packing out for  
small stores  
Middle part thick fog wind  
S.W. steering S.W.  
later part the same  
Lat 56.58. N  
Long 132.25 E

Monday June 21<sup>th</sup>

First of this day fine weather  
Strong breeze from S.W. steering  
S. Middle part thick fog  
at 11 am taken in the top sail and  
hauled up the courses. at 4 P.M.  
set them, again. at 3 P.M. bore  
ship heading. S.W. wind. S.W.  
No obs

Tuesday June 22<sup>nd</sup>

First of this day thick fog  
wind S.W. heading S.W.  
by the wind middle part the same  
later part fine weather, wind S.W.  
heading S.W. saw nothing  
Lat 56.00. N  
Long 139.25 E

Bark *Apidae* of P. Tallman Master  
Wednesday June 23

First of this day fine weather  
wind S.W. heading W  
with all sail  
Middle part wind S steering  
W later part thick wind S  
steering W saw nothing

Lat 56.00. N  
Long 135.30 E

Thursday June 24

First of this day thick fog  
wind S steering W  
Middle part thick fog wind S.E  
steering S.W. short sail. at 6 P.M.  
saw ship China and gamed  
later part steering S.W.  
with wind S.E. so ends this day

No observation

Friday June 25<sup>th</sup>

First of this day thick wind  
S.E. steering N.W. at 3 am  
huffed to head. N.E. at 7 am  
bore ship head S.W.  
Middle part at 12 bore ship  
head S.W. later part rained  
at 1.0 P.M. hit up got an algate
