

Remarks for July 1858

Tuesday July 20th

Calm & light airs and
very thick fog all the boats
off at 7 PM the harbor boat
came on board had got a whale
in the ice got the ship under
way and tried to get to the
whale. but the fog and thick
fog had to anchor.

Wednesday July 21st

at 2 am the boat left for
the whale at 7 PM 2 boats came
to the ship at 3 am 2 boats
started for the fast boats
at 7 am whale along side at 8 am
cuffing at 12 finished thick
fog

Thursday July 22nd

Cleared off commenced
boiling the boats on board
at 3 am 2 boats off whaling very
thick fog boiling

Friday July 23rd

Continued thick & boats off
whaling and 2 on board boiling
latter part finished boiling
4 boats off

Bark offides of R Salmon Whistler

Saturday July 24th

very foggy the boats off whaling
latter part do

Sunday July 25th

at 4 PM 2 boats came on board moved
the ship up to the whaler just

Monday July 26th

Ship at anchor the fast bearing
at 6 miles foot of ice 2 boats
gone through the ice to Shantler
Island all this day thick fog

Tuesday July 27th

at anchor off Shantler got
the boats off in the ice and fog
looking for whales saw nothing

Wednesday July 28th

Heavy swell from N.E. the boats
off whaling 2 boats came
on board showed down 15 bls of oil
Calm & foggy

Thursday July 29th

all the boats on board at 8 am 3 boats
left for the ice at 10 got under way at 12 anchored

Friday July 30th

at anchor all the boats off in the
ice very thick fog

Saturday July 31st

the boats all off whaling up
in the gut in the ice very thick
fog
