

Remarks for August 1858

Sunday August 1st

The Boats off whaling foggy
later part one boat came on board
moved the ship up into the gut

Monday Aug 2nd

Boats off whaling in the foggy later
part one boat came on board all this
day thick fog

Tuesday Aug 3rd

Very foggy Boats off whaling in the
bay in Shanters Bay saw several whales
but did not shoot started out at 10

Wednesday August 4th

Boats off in Shanters Bay later
part one Boat on board

Thursday Aug 5th

Run through the gut and
anchored later part the Boats
came on board

Friday Aug 6th

No fog in the bay and the whales
left saw about 50 ships and 500
boats saw the D woods boats taken 3 or 4

Sunday Aug 7th

Boats off in the bay at 10 pm moved
the ship down the bay

Monday 8th

2 Boats came on board sent them off
again saw plenty of whales and
plenty of boats moved the ship

Remarks of R. Tallman Chapter

Tuesday August 1st

2 Boats came on board started off
again later part strong breeze at 10
very rugged the ship trying off 2 boats

Wednesday 10th

Strong wind from S. S. ship
Riding a single anchor about
3 miles from the land all the
Boats off and could not get on
board

Thursday August 11

all the Boats came on board got the
ship under way at 9 pm came to
anchor at 2 gal ft

Friday Aug 12th

drooged the ship to Foklistoff
harbor sent 2 Boats looking for
water got 1 raft of water and 3
boat loads of food sent the steamer
anchor to the ship Reindeer

Saturday 13th

at anchor in Foklistoff getting
wood & water
Let the gun
Wood have 2 casks
of Bread 191-197

Saturday 14th

getting wood and water & Foklistoff
thick fog

Sunday 15th

getting ready for sea
thick fog
