

Remarks for August 1858

Monday August 16th
Took our anchor from the
bluffs and stood over for the
N^o Shore

Tuesday 17th
Running to westward I & son anchored
between round Sol and the rocks

Wednesday 18th
Calm 3 Boats off whaling saw
whales going quick

Thursday 19th
3 Boats off saw whales but could
not strike at 4 pm took our anchor
at 8 pm anchored again

Friday 20th
Saw plenty of whales but could
not strike took our anchor

Saturday 21st
Saw whales but could not
strike at 8 pm anchored
a striped head

Sunday 22nd
Working up the North Shore
saw plenty of ships. like airc
and bafflin

Monday Aug 23rd
First of this day calm
Middel part like breeze from E.
later part wind increases working
up along the land strong breeze
from N.E.

Tuesday August 24th

First of this day blowing fresh
from S.E. working to the S. and
Eastward at 7 am saw whales
board did not strike Middel part
blowing heavy from S.E. Ship
working to westward later part
saw whales board 2 Boats, called
them onboard blowing heavy
from S.E. holding on under
short sail

Wednesday Aug 25th

First of this day blowing heavy
from S.E. Ship holding on
under short sail Middel part
moderate at 5 PM saw whales loped
and struck one lost him by the Boat
going crossed the land bearing N.W.
distant 10 miles pickelstopp bearing
S.E. 40 miles

Thursday August 26th

First of this day fine weather
wind a S.W. heavy swell from
N.E. saw whales the west Boat struck
and lost line, Larbord Boat struck
and drewel Middel part wind
like and bafflin ship by the wind
making short boards later part
strong breeze a W. steering S.E.
saw 2 ships to the Southward
land bearing W dist 10 miles
Lat 55.47. N
Long 137.31. E
