First of this day fine weather
wind S.W. steering N.E. land
to westward dist 10 miles
middle part calm later part a
7 pm light breeze from N.E. heading
N.W. a 12 tacked ship land
to westward dist 8 miles
Lat 57.45. N

Friday September 3rd

First of this 24 hours fine weather
wind @ S.E. heading N.E.
land distant 10 miles
middle part calm later part a 3 pm
light breeze from S.E. steering
N.E. a 10 wind @ S.W. steering
N.E. by N land distant 15 miles
Lat 58.13. N
Long 141.01. E

Saturday Sept 4th

First of this day fine weather
wind @ S.W. steering N.E. saw nothing
worth note middle part blowing fresh
from S and raining later part
thick wind @ S.E. working off shore
off Cochocks city

Bark headed by R. Tallman Chapter
Sunday Sept 5th

First of this day thick
and rainy, wind @ S.E.
middle part a 10 wind @ S.W. &
heading S.E. a 12 bore ship heading
N. blowing fresh from S.W. &
later part moderate wind @ S.W.
stood in shore a 11 pm tacked
off shore land dist 10 miles
Spoke Bark
this frigate

Monday Sept 6th

First of this day thick
thick wind @ S.E. working to N.E.
middle part light air and calm
heading in shore later part
wind @ N.E. heading S.E. land
distant 20 miles
Lat 59.10. N
Long 145.06. E

Tuesday Sept 7th

First of this 24 hours fine
weather wind @ S.E. or S.W.
steering N.E. saw a ship
close in shore a 4 am land
distant 4 miles middle part
light breeze from S.W. steering
S.E. by E later part calm
saw 1 ship in shore land dist
10 miles
Lat 59.00. N
Long 146.00. E
