

Remarks For September 1858
Wednesday Sept 8th

First of this day 24 hours like air
and calm steering E
Middle part fine breeze at S.E. W
steering S.E. E, later part steering
E N.E. at 6 pm saw foggy island
bearing E of S distant 30 miles
lat 59 15 N
Long 148 29 E

Thursday Sept 9th

First of this day strong breeze
at S.E. W steering E at 4 am
foggy island bearing N.W. dist
2 miles Middle part wind at S
toping with head yards aback
steering S.E. E later part at 6 pm
standing in to the bay at 1
round island bearing N.W. dist
4 miles

Friday Sept 10th

First of this day calm round
island bearing N.W. S.W. at 1 am
island bearing S.E. W dist 8 miles
at 1 am like breeze from S.E. W steering
E at 12 strong breeze at 6 pm to head
island bearing E dist 10 miles
at 9 pm sent the 2 quarter Boats
in shore

Bark, Nicolas J. B. Gellman Master
Saturday Sept 11th

First of this day calm
at 5 am the boats came on board
saw nothing strong breeze
from N heading W.W. W
middle part working to the N and
westward later part like breeze
from E at 11 pm came to anchor
at Jarvis Island in 12 fathoms
of water sent 2 Boats down
the shore and S. of the Island
saw 5 whales

Sunday Sept 12th

Bloing fresh saw nothing
at dark all the Boats
on board bloing from
E.N.E. and raining

Monday Sept 13

Bloing strong from
N.E. and thick all the Boats
on board

Tuesday Sept 14th

First of this day thick with
heavy snow from S.E. saw 2 whales

Wednesday Sept 15th

This day fine weather all the
Boats off whaling saw 2 whales
later part snow squalls
