October Friday 1st

First of this 24 hours fine
weather like breeze from S.E.
heading S.E. & all sail
showed shapes and anchored
Middle part wind a S.E. steering
S.E. & later part like air
and bafflin with rain
No observation

Saturday Oct 2nd

First of this 24 hours calm
a 5 p.m. like breeze a S.P.E.
steering E Middle part like air
and bafflin later part like breeze
a 8 p.m. steering E with
all sail a 10 calm
Lat 55.30 N
Long 155.20 E

Sunday Oct 3rd

First of this day fine weather
like breeze a S.E. steering E with
all sail Middle part like breeze
a 11 p.m. steering E by S
Later part like air and calm
Lat 55.29 N
Long 152.09 E

Monday Oct 4th

First of this day fine weather
like air and bafflin steering
E Middle part wind a S. head
a 3 p.m. wind a S.E. heading
S.E. a 10 p.m. heading E S strong
breeze
No observation

Tuesday Oct 5th

First of this day blowing fresh a S.E.
heading E by S a 8 a.m. taken in
fly jibs and gaff topsail a 5 a.m.
stood main fore and sail a 7 a.m.
looped reefed the topsails
Middle part blowing fresh a
S.P.E. steering E by S
Later part steering E by S
with 2 reefed topsails blowing
fresh in squalls
No obs

Wednesday Oct 6th

First of this day blowing
fresh a S.E. steering E
with all prudent sail heavy
snow squalls Middle part
blowing fresh in squalls from
S.P. steering E by S with 2 reef topsails
Later part moderated wind a S.P.
steering E by S all sail saw nothing
worth note Lat 54.51 N
Long 152.52 E
