

Remarks for October 1858

Thursday Oct 7th

First of this day, strong breeze
a W steering S.E. at 4 am equally
middle part strong breeze a S.W.
and squalls with snow. Later part
wind a W steering S.E. with
rough sea

Long 152.55 E

Friday Oct 8th

First part, strong breeze a
S.W. steering S.E. spoke the
Bark Landa middle part
being too with short sail. frequent
squalls passing over. Latter
part steering S.E. with
reefed topsails and first
day's ship steering S. with
all sail

Lat 52.37 N
Long 154.00 E

Saturday Oct 9th

First of this day strong breeze
a N.W. steering S.E. rough sea
saw 1 ship to the northward
middle part wind a N.W. steering
S.E. at 11 luffed too with head of sail
asack. at 6 pm set off to south
at 1 pm wind a S.W. and cloudy
heading S.E. with all sail
saw large island bearing S.E.
distant 15 miles

Bark Mides of R. Callman Master
Sunday Oct 10th

First of this day strong breeze
a S.W. at 1 am heading N.W.
at 8 am backed head S. at 6. backed
head S.W. thick over head
at 8 am wore ship head S.W. and a
W. at 11 middle part the same
thick cloudy weather latter part
like breeze a S.W. steering S.E.
saw the land bearing E. to S.E.

Lat 50.33 N
Long 154.38 E

Monday October 11th

First of this day like air and calm
steering S by E land to the eastward
the 50 passage bearing S.E. dist 80 miles
at 7 am backed ship head to wind a S.W.
at 11 backed head S. wind steady thick
latter part at 2 pm backed head W
at 5 pm backed head S. at 1 commenced
raining at 10 saw the land bearing S.E.
dist 10 m backed head W
thick rainy weather

Tuesday Oct 12th

First of this day strong gale a
S. beating to windward at 9 am
saw the rays of S.E. dist
10 miles backed to the westward
middle part working up for the
passage latter part thick fog
wind a S.E. at 12 saw a small island
and rock dist 12 m bearing S. heading
S.E.
