

Remarks for Oct. 1858.

Wednesday Oct. 13th

First of this day thick weather like
sweezed and bafflin from the eastward
at 2 AM blowing fresh at E heading
N.W. with dark clouds of shells
land bearing E by S dist 20.5 m
Middle part wind jibe and
bafflin at 11, wind S.W. head
at 12 N.W. with all sail later
part at 2 pm thick and jumpy wind
shifted to S.W. blowing heavy head
S.W. at 6 saw the ground east off
steering E.S.E with 2 reef topsails

Thursday Oct. 14th

First of this day strong S.W. gale
steering E.S.E at 1 am unexpected
bearing all and perpendicular at
at 7 am fully in the N Pacific
steering E wind N.W. middle part steering
E by S, strong westerly gale. Later
part moderate wind S.W. steering
E with all sail

Lat 48.48. N
Long 158.39. E

Friday October 15th

First of this day like breeze at N.W.
steering E by N, we have a heavy
swell from N.E middle part
wind like from E at 10 AM wore ship
head by E, later part wind at E head
N.W. with heavy head swell
cloudy. No observation

Saturday Oct 16th

First of these 24 hours like breeze
from E heading S.W. E
Middle part at 11 wore ship head S.W. E
puffing squalls and rain at 1 pm taken
in the topgallant sails and fly jib
at 2 o'clock reefed later part blowing
on 9 showed jib and spanker
blowing strong and raining at 5 wind
veered to S.W. wore ship steering E
at 9 blowing heavy ship labring hard
in heavy sea
Lat 49.26. N; Long 161.30. E

Sunday Oct 17th

First of this 24 hours strong S.W. gale
steering E both reefed topsails
at 4 am all sail fine clear weather with
roff sea at 10 am wind S.E. heading S.E
at 12 blowing on part 2 reefs in topsails
very thick and heavy later part
at 4 pm wind S.W. steering E
at 7 wind S.E. at 10 wind S.W. steering
E by S with all sail to end this day
Lat 49.47. N
Long 163.09. E

Monday Oct. 18th

First of this 24 hours fine westerly
gale steering E by S with all sail
middle part all again later part
at 2 pm commenced blowing from S.E
at 6 hours too with close reefed
main topsail blowing heavy in
squalls near S.E
