Monday April 4th 1859 Remarks on board

This day begins with strong breeze from S.W.
Shut in Nov. 24 casks for water one watch on liberty nothing
more of note passing so ends this day on board
Several junkies came in to day capt. mind of the ship cut off
very sick and think he will not survive long. got on board
22 casks of water 112 sacks of potatoes stowed down
10 bbls. of water one watch on liberty

Tuesday April 5th 1859 Remarks on board the master

This day comes in fine pleasant weather employed
in various things one watch on liberty so ends the day

Wednesday April 6th 1859 Remarks on board

Fine weather got on board 10 casks water so ends
One watch on liberty

On Co Whaling Voyage J. R. Tallman Master C. D. 1859

Thursday April 7th 1859 Fine weather all things
Ready for sea wind and weather not permitting
Did not go sent two boats claiming George W.
Williams and John L. Rose stole rum or
what they call sacker got beastly drunk after much
trouble got them on board got the rums on to George
Williams but took them off stowed him away
In the steerage J. L. rose saw very well for a
drunken man so ends the day

Friday April 8th 1859 Remarks on board

This day begins with stormy weather at 8 am got
Under way stood out of the bay it coming on thick
and rainy from S.W. came in again come to anchor
Ten 6 fathoms water 50 fathoms chain ahead
drop in the seaboard anchor under foot so ends
the day blowing a gale from S.W.

Saturday April 9th 1859 Remarks on board

This day comes in strong breeze from S.W. took the large
Anchor capt went on shore.
