Thursday November 10th

First part of these 24 hours fine
with all hands employed at work
stowing down oil from the Bk Gratitude
and painting down the spars latter
part the Bk watch on liberty and
painting the ship outside
so ends the day

Remarks Friday November 11th

First part of these 24 hours
fine weather painting ship outside
latter part fine weather painting
ship on the outside sent the
Laboard watch ashore on liberty
so ends the day

Remarks Saturday November 12th

First part of these 24 hours
fine with showers of rain latter
part fine at work painting ship
getting of provisions and water
casks and stowing of the fire and
after hatch took on board 10 barrels
of pork and three barrels of
beef stowed down 60 barrels of
water casks in the afternoon hauled
so ends the day
