Thursday January 5th
First part of these 24 hours strong
gale from the West ship steering East
took in the main top gallant sail
the weather looking bad some squally
latter part strong breeze and good weather
from the West ship steering East set the
main royal and studding sails
started a cask of flour 4 1/2 barrels
so ends the day

Long 126:38

Friday January 6th
First part of these 24 hours
strong breeze and rough weather
from the N W ship steering East
all sail set took in the lee
studding sail latter part strong wind
and clear weather from the W ship
steering E took in the main
royal and studding sails
so ends the day

Saturday January 7th

Lat 48:49
Long 122:32

First part of these 24 hours
strong wind and clear weather from
the West ship steering East under
double reef fore top sail whole main top
sail and main top gallant sail some main
top gallant braces a fair of wheel rope
latter part good weather the wind
more moderate the wind W set the
main royal and studding sails
ship steering East
so ends the day

Thursday January 8th
First part of these 24 hours strong breeze
and good weather from the West ship
steering East easing studding sails fore and
aft the wind built latter part strong breeze
the wind built to the North took
in the studding sails ship
steering East with all her studding
sails set
so ends the day

Monday January 9th
First part of these 24 hours strong
breeze and weather sailing from the
North took in the light sails
and double reefed the top sail ship
steering East middle part moderate wind
sail latter part light breeze and a
thick fog from the W ship steering
East with all sail set the studding
sails
so ends the day

Tuesday January 10

Lat 51:04
Long 110:15
First part of these 24 hours strong
breeze and thick weather from
the W ship steering East
with all sail set with studding
sails latter part strong breeze and
clear weather but rugged from the
W ship steering East with all
sail we are having a fine run
started some molasses
so ends the day
