

Remarks on Board the Bk Miles of N. Bedford

Thursday February 16

Lat 25-21 First part of these 24 hours light breeze and good weather from the S W ship steering N by W with all sail employed in setting up the lead stays and rattling down the fore rigging started some fresh water into the tank broke out lead and fork butter
Long 26-47 lat light breeze and good weather from the S W ship heading N W boarded a French bark 17 days from Saigon bound to Marseilles 10 miles the day

Friday February 17

Lat 25-05 First part of these 24 hours light breeze and fine weather from the S W ship heading North with all sail at work repairing the rigging and turning one sail in sight latter part light breeze and fine weather from the S W ship heading N E with all sail employed at work on the rigging two sails in sight 10 miles the day

Saturday February 18

Lat 24-24 First part of these 24 hours light breeze and good weather from the S W ship heading N by W with all sail employed in setting up the jib and fly jib gages and turning two sails in sight latter part light breeze and fine weather from the S W ship steering N by W with the studding sails one sail in sight steering to the North at work and the rigging 10 miles the day

Sunday February 19

Lat 23-57 First part of these 24 hours light breeze and fine weather from the S E ship steering N by W with all sail with two ships in sight one steering North one steering to the Eastward latter part light breeze and good weather from the S E ship steering N by W with all sail took in the studding sails two sails in sight 10 miles the day

Monday February 20

Lat 22-10

First part of these 24 hours light breeze and fine weather from the S E ship steering N by W with all sail and the studding sails again boarded the ship signs of sand 47 days from Calcutta bound to Swatow latter part light breeze and good weather from the S E ship heading N W with all sail in the studding sails 8 ships in sight started at tank of water 10 miles the day

Tuesday February 21

Lat 21-09

First part of these 24 hours light breeze and fine weather from the S E ship heading N N W with all sail spoke the ship Sarah of Mattapoiet Captain Butler 50 days out clear latter part light breeze and good weather from the S E ship heading N N W with all sail 2 ships in sight sold the ship Sarah of Mattapoiet Cap Butler 3 pipes of brand and one short case gauges 271-276-284-178 10 miles the day
