

Remarks on Board Bk, Midas on

Friday March 23

Lat 31-14 N First part of these 24 hours a strong gale and rigged from the WNW ship heading N by W close reef fore topsail and double reef main saw one sail steering to the SE latter part strong breeze and a heavy head swell the wind from the W ship heading NNE with double reef topsail and courses sounds by day

Saturday March 24

Lat 32-48 First part of these 24 hours strong breeze and gugged weather from the WNW ship heading NNE with double reef topsail and courses jib and spencer latter part a heavy gale from the SW ship heading NNE with close reef main topsail and main spencer heading NNE by W sounds the day

Sunday March 25

Lat 33-22 N First part of these 24 hours a heavy gale from the SW ship heading NNE with close reef main topsail and main spencer heading NNE by W a try fore reef steering to the Eastward latter part light breeze and good weather from the SE ship steering NNE by N half N with all sail two sails in sight sounds the day

Her Passage Home From The S. Islands 1860

Monday March 26

Lat 34-07 N First part of these 24 hours strong breeze and rainy weather from the SW ship steering NNE by N with all sail set middle part strong heavy thunder squalls latter part strong breeze and good weather from the NNE ship heading NNE with double reef topsail and courses two sails in sight sounds the day

Tuesday March 27

Lat 34-58 N First part of these 24 hours light breeze and good weather from the WNW ship heading NNE with all sail set middle part strong breeze and squalls from the NNE ship heading NNE with double reef topsail and courses two sails in sight sounds the day

Wednesday March 28

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze and good weather from the WNW ship heading NNE with all sail two sails in sight middle part were ship heading WNW light sail all in latter part light breeze and rainy weather from the NNE ship heading NNE by N half N with all sail sounds the day
