

Thursday September the 22th 1831

These 24 Hours Commences Good weather
And Strong Breeze from N E And
then to N N E Middle part Squally
Latter part Strong Breeze Saw
Several fin Back whales So Ends
these 24 Hours Lat By obs 34-10
Long 10-49 West

Friday September the 23th 1831
These 24 Hours Commences Good
weather And Strong Breeze the wind
180th Saw several fin Back whales
And at 6 Took in sail and Hove her
to Middle part Squally and at 6 made
Sail and at 10 PM Sailed Ship
So Ends these 24 Hours Lat By
obs 34-25 Long 8-45

Saturday September the 24th 1831

These 24 Hours Commences Strong
Breeze And Squally And at 4
Took in the Ship Victory of
London Bound to the East Indies
And at 6 Took in sail and Hove her
to Middle part Squally and Breeze
And at 11 PM made Some sail
So Ends these 24 Hours Lat By obs 34-18
Long 8-08 West

Sunday September the 25th 1831
These 24 Hours Commences Strong
Breeze from South And some Squally
And at 6 Took in sail and Hove her
to Middle And latter part more
the wind N E & Breeze in sight
So Ends Lat By obs 34-02 Long 8-00

Monday September the 26th 1831
These 24 Hours Commences Good weather
And Light winds from N E & Middle
part Calm Latter part Light Breeze
Sail in sight So Ends these 24 Hours
Lat By obs 38-00 Long 8-00
