

Tuesday November the 1st 1830

All these 24 Hours Strong
Breeze And at 5 AM Coaled
Down on Account of wind And
at 5 PM went to Tying Sails
Several whale But to Tuggan
to Lower So Ends these 24
Hours Lat By 38. 23 Long 8. 15

Wednesday November the 2nd 1831

First and Middle part Strong Breeze
And at 10 AM finished Tying sails
at 6 PM Commenced Stowing Down
and at 8. Saw 2 whale and Lower
And the waist Boat Struck
And the Starboard Boat and the
waist Boat Killed them both
And Saved one So Ends these
24 Hours Lat By 38. 41
Long 4. 35

Thursday November the 3rd 1831

All these 24 Hours Good weather
By at 3 Got the whale Along
Side and finished Stowing Down
and at 6 PM Commenced Cutting
and at 10 finished So Ends 3 Sail
in Sight one man of Duty
Lat By 38. 29 Long 5. 00

Friday November the 4th 1831

All these 24 Hours Good weather
And at 4 Saw 2 or 3 whale But
Did not Get fast and at 4 PM
Spoke the Ship Fame of Kentuck
and at 4 Saw 2 whale and
Lower And the waist Boat
And Starboard Got fast and
the waist Boat Drowned and
the Starboard Boat Killed
the 2 Boats whale and at
9 Got her Alongside and
Commenced Cutting and
at 12 finished So Ends these
24 Hours Lat By 38. 39
Long 4. 40
