First and Latter part Strong Breeze
 And at 3 spoke the Ship Kimora
 of Sougharique and at 5 spoke
 the Ship Mercator of New Bedford
 5 whale Latter part Good weather
 And at 10 spoke the Heroine
 of Fairhaven 11 whale So Ends
 these 24 Hours No Lat this
 Day Long 5-00 West

Saturday November the 12th 1831
 All these 24 Hours Good weather
 And at 4 Saw 3 whale and the
 waist Boat struck and the
 Larchard Boat killed and at
 6 Got there Longside
 Middle and Latter and at
 5 PM commenced cutting
 and at 9 finished and saw
 several whale and lowered
 And the waist Boat struck
 And the Larchard Boat killed
 And the waist Boat killed
 Saw whale But did not save them
