All these 24 Hours Good weather  
And at 1 Got the whale Lonside  
And commenced cutting and at  
6 finished and went to Boiling  
And at 6 PM Saw several whale  
And toward and the mast boat  
stuck and killed and at 9 Got  
her Lonside So Ends Lat By  
obs 39 50 Long 4 15 4 ships in sight

Monday November the 14<sup>th</sup> 1831  
First and Middle part Good  
weather and at 2 commenced cutting  
And at 6 finished Latter part  
Strong Breeze Several ships  
in sight So Ends Employed  
in Boiling So Ends the 24  
Hours Lat By obs 39 50  
Long 4 00 West

Tuesday November the 15<sup>th</sup> 1831

All these 24 Hours Good weather  
And at 3 Spoke the ship John  
Adams of Nantucket 9 whale  
4 ships in sight So Ends  
Employed in Boiling So Lat  
this Day Long 3 45

Wednesday November the 16<sup>th</sup> 1831  
First and Middle part Good  
weather and at 1 commenced  
Stowing Down and at 6 finished  
4 ships in sight and at 8 PM  
went to Stowing Down So Ends  
Employed in Boiling Lat By  
obs 38 12 Long 3 30 West

Thursday November the 17<sup>th</sup> 1831  
First and Middle part Strong  
Breeze and at 5 finished Stowing  
Down Saw a big Steaming East  
And at 8 Coaled Down on account  
of Rain And at 9 PM went to  
Boiling Latter part Fugged and Rain  
So Ends So Lat this Day Long 3 00
