All These 24 Hours Good weather And Spoke the Ship Louisa of Linn 1000 Tons And Spoke the Ship Rome of Bristol a whale Saw 1 whale And Loward but Did not Get fast So Ends Lot By als 34-22 Long 3:50

First part Good weather Saw Several fin Backs and at 4 Spoke the Ship Nimrod of Sagharbour 1500 Tons And at 6 Saw A. D. whale went to her and took her Longside And Spoke the Hope And at Day Light cut her in And went to Boiling 3 Ships in Sight So Ends Lot By als 34-44 Long 2-45 West
