First and Middle part Strong
Breeze and foggy latter part
fair and sail of wind at 2 Cool
Down to Endeavor. Saw several
Whales So far this day long 4 30

Saturday January the 14th 1832
All these 24 Hours A Gail of
Wind Saw several whales and
saw 2 ships to Endeavor these 24
Hours Lot By 40 25 Long 4 00

Sunday January the 15th 1832
First part Strong Breeze at 2
went to Boiling Middle part
Light Breeze 1 ship in sight
and at 2 saw a whale toward
and the Standard Boat struck
and parted to Endeavor Lot By
40 30 Long 4 40
Employed in Boiling and
Stowing Down

Monday January the 16th 1832

All these 24 Hours Good weather
and at 4 saw several whale
toward and the Standard
Boat struck and the wait
boat killed and at 6 took
her alongside and at daylight
cut her in to Endeavor Lot By
40 00 Long 4 50 West

Tuesday January the 17th 1832
All these 24 Hours Good weather
Saw several whales employed
in Stowing Down Middle and
latter part Light Breeze
and at 10 saw a large whale
and at 11 took her alongside
to Endeavor 2 ships in sight Lot By
40 10 Long 4 00 West
