in Stowing Down Middle And
 Latter part Light winds
Employed in Stowing Down
So Ends Lat Byals 34-35 South
Long 6-10 West

Friday January the 27th 1832

All these 24 Hours Light winds
And Calm First part Employed
in Churning Bone Latter part
Employed in Ship Duty
So Ends these 24 Hours Lat
Byals 34-10 Long 6-38 West

Saturday January the 28th 1832
First part Calm Middle And
 Latter part Light winds from
SE So Ends these 24
Hours Lat Byals
36-08 Long 6-08 West

Sunday January the 29th 1832
All these 24 Hours Fresh
Breeds with the Same Foggy
Bothing for light to clear

34-39 Long 6-20 West
