2 11 AM These 24 hours commence with
 4 moderate weather and raining saw
 6 nothing but one or two phinbacks
 8
 10 Middle part strong winds and
 12 raining
 2
 4 Latter part strong wind and very
 6 rugged with some rain saw nothing
 8 employed in cutting up the blubber
 10 and putting it in casks
 12

W H F C W L Remarks Saturday 22nd

2 11 AM These 24 hours commence with a strong
 4 breeze but quite clear commence
 6 boiling saw Denis Island one of
 8 the Seychelle Islands
 10
 12 Middle the same employed in
 2 boiling

 6 Latter part strong breeze with some
 8 rainy squalls saw one or two phinbacks
 10 and the land again employed in
 12 boiling &

W H F C W L Remarks Saturday 23rd

2 11 AM These 24 hours common with a strong
 4 breeze and rugged saw nothing at
 6 8 PM finish boiling
 8
 10 Middle part the same
 12

 6 rugged saw nothing but some
 8 phinbacks
 10
 12

W H F C W L Remarks Monday 24th

2 11 AM These 24 hours commence with a strong
 4 breeze saw a number of phinbacks and
 6 saw one sperm whale he saw turned his
 8 flock and when it was time for him to
 10 come up there came a heavy rain squall
 12 and we saw no more of him also saw the
 2 Island of Praslin
 4 Middle part heavy squalls of wind and rain
 6 Latter part strong winds and heavy squalls
 8 saw and spoke the Ship Tiger Capt Fox
 10 nine months out we carried of sperm oil
 12 also saw some porpoises and phinbacks and the
 land to a distance

W H F C W L Remarks Tuesday 25th

2 11 AM These 24 hours commence with strong winds
 4 and heavy squalls very rugged saw one
 6 phinback and game with the ship until
 8 near night
 10 Middle part more moderate
 12
 2 Latter part heavy squalls of wind
 4 and rain saw the same ship to a
 6 distance also saw phinbacks porpoises &
 8 split our jill by pieces and got out a
 10 new cotton jill and bent it
 12 Jan

W H F C W L Remarks Wednesday 26

2 11 AM These 24 hours commence with a
 4 steady rain and some thunder saw
 6 the ship get astern and one or two
 8 phinbacks
 10 Middle part rather more moderate
 12
 2
 4 Latter part finer weather however but one
 6 heavy squall saw nothing but a
 8 few phinbacks
 10
