

Remarks Onboard Ship Arabella July 1852

H H F C W S Remarks Saturday 27th

These 24 hours commence with a calm saw nothing but the land finish stowing off &c

Middle part the same

Latter part calm saw nothing but the land two or three islands ends with cloudy weather

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H H F C W S Remarks Sunday 28th

These 24 hours commence with light air and calms saw nothing but land and a few porpoises

Middle part strong wind and squally

Latter part strong breeze saw nothing but Johanna close by got up the chains and bent them and got the anchors of the bow

H H F C W S Remarks Monday 29th

These 24 hours commence with fine weather at 2 o'clock drop our anchor at Johanna and wash the ship out side &c got one Bullock from shore

Middle part fine weather at 3 o'clock the Capt came onboard

Latter part fine weather employed in getting a raft of water onboard

H H F C W S Remarks Tuesday 30th

These 24 hours commence with fine weather hoist in our water &c

Middle part the same

Latter part fine weather commence painting ship Starboard mack goes on liberty took onboard 18 barrels of Tarrak &c

H H F C W S Remarks Wednesday 31st

These 24 hours commence with a fine breeze on shore employed in painting ship and took up 5 barrels of Tarrak at sundown the mack came onboard

Middle part the same

Latter part fine weather the Starboard mack goes on liberty the rest employed in painting and getting some recruits off from shore one French Man of War arrived here

H H F C W S Remarks Thursday 1st

These 24 hours commence with fine weather at sundown the mack came onboard got another bullock &c

Middle part the same

Latter part calm and very warm the Starboard mack goes again on liberty the rest employed in painting ship
