H H F C W S Remarks Friday 2nd

These 24 hours commence with strong breezes from the land at sundown the pack came on board employed in painting &c
Middle part the same
 Latter part strong breeze and squalls off the land employed in getting off recruits painting &c the larboard watch goes on liberty

H H F C W S Remarks Saturday 3rd

These 24 hours commence with fine weather employed in getting off recruits
Middle part the same
 Latter part rainy weather the starboard watch goes on liberty again

H H F C W S Remarks Sunday 4th

These 24 hours commence with fine weather the watch on shore &c
Middle part the same
 Latter part moderate weather with some rain the watch goes on liberty again the rest employed in getting off recruits

H H F C W S Remarks Monday 5th

These 24 hours commence with fine weather employed in storing down water got of one bullock &c
Middle part the same
 Latter fine weather the watch goes on liberty again the rest employed in getting off a raft of water and storing it down

H H F C W S Remarks Tuesday 6th

These 24 hours commence with fine weather finish storing down water got of some coconuts and other recruits from shore
Middle part the same
 Latter part got off the bullock to take to sea the watch goes on shore &c also got off another small raft of water and store it away

H H F C W S Remarks Wednesday 7th

These 24 hours commence with fine weather employed in getting of another bullock from shore and some grass to feed them on getting the ship ready for sea &c
Middle part the same at 4 o'clock H H called all hands and got under way
 Latter part fine weather with light puffing wind and calm employed in working off from the land storing cables and anchors all aboard and all well
