2 NNE NW These 24 hours commence with a light breeze and fine weather saw nothing but the same land at sundown made the Island called Banjawan bearing S by E 6 leagues Dis Middle part the same with some thunders and lightning

4 SSW Latter part fine weather with a light breeze all sail set at daylight saw the Island of Saraw bearing S by E 6 leagues also saw a plenty of porpoises

Sun 121 71 E

W. H. F. C. W. S. Remarks Tuesday 17th

2 NNE NW These 24 hours commence with a light breeze and fine weather saw nothing but some porpoises and grampuses employed in ships duty

4 SSW Middle part the same

6 W Latter part fine weather with a light baffling breeze saw nothing but a few porpoises at noon saw land bearing N and W by W Dis 10 leagues Flores and Solar Islands

W. H. F. C. W. S. Remarks Wednesday 18th

2 E SSW These 24 hours commence with a fine breeze and pleasant weather saw the same land and some porpoises employed in ships duty

4 NNE SE Middle part light baffling winds and calms with some rain

6 W Latter part calm saw at daylight a plenty of blackfish however one boat but of no use could not get not get near enough also saw Timore on one side Sablen and Panice on the

2 S by E SW These 24 hours commence with a light air saw nothing but the land on both sides at 1 o'clock 1/2 the men in Irons misty to get to their duty after promising faithfully to behave themselves here after their Irons was taken off and the men sent forward at 4 o'clock 1/2 the band the cables and got the anchors off the

4 calm bore

6 Middle part light winds and calms with a plenty of thunders and lightning

8 SSW Latter part calm saw nothing saw nothing but the land on both sides

10 Calm to the North and Timore on the South

W. H. F. C. W. S. Remarks Friday 20th

2 S by E NW These 24 hours commence with a light air and fine weather saw nothing but the land thick and smoky weather

4 SSW Middle part light breeze lay dark the most of the night saw the land

6 W Latter part light breeze and thick hazy weather star for Bello Gady a Portugues settlement on Timore Island at 1/2 o'clock the Capt took a boat and started for the shore

W. H. F. C. W. S. Remarks Saturday 21st

2 These 24 hours commence with a light breeze and thick smoky weather at 2 o'clock the Capt landed his scow came aboard and at 4 1/2 o'clock dropped anchor 2 or 3 cables lengths from shore fired the sails in 25 fathoms of water got one hog and a few spams from shore and kill the dog &c

4 Middle part fine weather the Capt stays on shore all night

6 Latter part calm one wreck was on shore on liberty took aboard 8 hogs and got a raft of coals on shore for water Thomas Penney brought aboard 5 bottles of liquor with him it was taken from him &c
