 2 at 7 o'clock at 11 a light breeze came of shore called
 4 all hands get the pilot and get underway at 4 set
 6 the pilot on shore cut one of the anchors
 8 Latter part light baffling winds and raining
 10 making off shore with 35 hogs two bullock
 12 and 2 tons of yams some fowl and coconuts onboard
