8 to the South also a plenty of porpoises and

4 latter part breeze commence beating
6 through Jaffes Straits also saw a
8 ship to leeward of us beating up the
10 same channel also saw a great
12 many porpoises

H H F C W L Remarks Saturday 6th

2 These 24 hours commence with a light
4 breeze and fine weather still trying to
6 get through saw at sundown 11 Island
8 mostly small and in every direction
10 also saw the other ship to leeward
12 Middle part light baffling winds
2 and squally

4 latter part light airs and calms with
6 thick weather saw and spoke the Barque
8 Frolick of London 27 months out
10 with 1200 spinn the light came on board
12

2 These 24 hours commence with a calm
4 the Capt went on board the Barque
6 and stopped a while and with rain
8 saw another sail in the straits saw
10 the same Islands and Jolly Island

4 latter part calms saw nothing but
6 the same Islands the ship and a
8 plenty of porpoises
